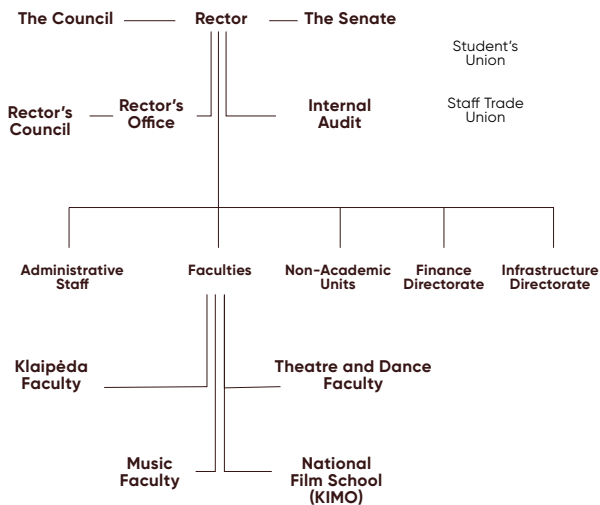


ABOUT LMTA

The Lithuanian Academy of Music and Theatre (**LMTA**) is a specialised art university whose mission is to ensure sustainable art and research activities, participate in the formation of Lithuania's policy of art education and culture, foster the spiritual harmony and national identity of the society, and educate young people with the most talent for art – young people who are creative, proactive, business-minded, and open to Lithuania and the whole world. In **Vilnius** and **Klaipėda**, the LMTA offers studies in music, theatre, film, dance, and art criticism as well as art and research activity in these fields. The LMTA has a **staff** body of about **500** and over **1,000 students**. Every year, about 100 foreign professionals arrive at the Academy to give lectures and workshops.



STRUCTURE



- The Academy is governed by two collegial bodies, the Council and the Senate.
- Rector is the head of the LMTA who acts on the behalf of the Academy and represents it.
- Vice-Rector is Deputy Rector of the LMTA.
- The LMTA has four faculties, an administrative unit, and other departments related to studies, arts, and research.
- The faculties have units – departments – responsible for conducting studies.

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ART AND RESEARCH

On average, the LMTA annually holds over **400–500 public art events**: about **350 concerts, 100 theatre and dance performances**, and **20 film screenings**. Most of these events are free of charge and open to Vilnius residents and other guests of the city. Works by the Academy's researchers are published in three LMTA research journals. Annually, the LMTA hosts around **10 conferences** and publishes several monographs and other research publications.

ACADEMIC ETHICS

The activities of the LMTA academic community members are rooted in the principles of academic ethics: **academic freedom, academic integrity, responsibility, collegiality and respect**. As members of the LMTA community, students must cherish the principles of academic integrity.

The LMTA's Code of Academic Ethics establishes the principle of respect for intellectual property, according to which there is no tolerance of any form of academic misconduct (plagiarism; falsification of scientific data; discrepancies in the allocation of credit to coauthors who are younger colleagues or subordinates; denial or non-acknowledgement of the contribution made by persons or organizations that have assisted the artistic, research, and social activity; copyright infringement; cheating at examinations and other tests; or other dishonest behaviour).

The regulations on academic ethics are outlined in the **LMTA's Code of Academic Ethics**. Cases of alleged violations of the LMTA's Code of Academic Ethics are to be reported by e-mail etika@lmta.lt or submitted in writing to the Chairperson of the LMTA Ethics Committee.

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STUDENT ID CARD

To be referred to as a student, you must have a student ID card. At the moment, you can choose from either the **Lithuanian Student Identity Card (in Lithuanian, LSP)** or the **International Student Identity Card (ISIC)**. Both ID cards:

STUDIES

THE LMTA SPECIALISES IN MUSIC, THEATRE, FILM, DANCE, AND ART CRITICISM OFFERING THREE-CYCLE STUDIES. NOW THE LMTA IS THE ONLY INSTITUTION IN LITHUANIA THAT PROVIDES UNIVERSITY-LEVEL STUDIES IN THE FIELDS OF FILM AND DANCE, AND ART DOCTORATE PROGRAMMES IN THE FIELDS OF MUSIC, THEATRE, AND FILM.

FIRST-CYCLE STUDIES

The first-cycle (bachelor's) study programmes aim at broadening general knowledge, acquiring theoretical basics of the field of study, and gaining professional skills necessary for independent work. These study programmes are oriented towards comprehensive education, acquiring theoretical knowledge and the highest level of professional skills. Students who have completed first-cycle university studies are awarded a **bachelor's degree**, which allows them to engage in professional activities and / or continue studies in a master's study programme.

THE TOTAL VOLUME OF STUDIES IS 240 CREDITS*. THE VOLUME OF ONE SEMESTER IS 30 CREDITS*.

*Study credit – a unit of the volume of studies. It measures average workload of the student required to achieve the learning outcomes. At the LMTA, one credit equals 26.66 hours of the student's work and consists of contact (classroom) hours and independent work time. More information about study credits is provided in the LMTA Regulations for Studies.

SECOND-CYCLE STUDIES

Second-cycle (master's) study programmes are intended to prepare for independent work in the fields of art or research or other kind of work that requires research-based knowledge and artistic, creative, and analytical skills. Students who have completed second-cycle studies are awarded a **master's degree** allowing them to engage in professional activities and / or continue studies at the doctorate level.

THE TOTAL VOLUME OF STUDIES IS 120 CREDITS*. THE VOLUME OF ONE SEMESTER IS 30 CREDITS*.

THIRD-CYCLE STUDIES

Third-cycle studies at the LMTA are offered as the art doctorate and PhD studies. The art doctorate aims at training an artist and researcher who can create, interpret, and develop research based on art practice. Students who have defended their artistic research project are awarded a **doctoral degree in art**. The purpose of PhD studies is to prepare a researcher who can independently conduct research and experimental (social, cultural) development work, and solve scientific problems. Students who have defended the thesis are awarded a **PhD**.

THE TOTAL VOLUME OF STUDIES IS 240 CREDITS*. THE VOLUME OF ONE SEMESTER IS 30 CREDITS*.

ADMINISTRATION OF STUDIES

The study process is administered by the staff of the faculties: deans, faculty administrators, heads and coordinators of departments.

SUSPENSION, TERMINATION, AND RESUMPTION OF STUDIES

SURVEYS AND FINANCING YOUR STUDIES

To receive feedback, the LMTA periodically conducts stakeholder surveys, so you are invited to actively participate in them.

Participation in surveys is voluntary and anonymous. The results of the surveys are used to update the curriculum, evaluate the teachers' performance, or review and update the study programme. The overall results of the surveys are discussed at meetings held by the Rectorate, deans, and departments. More information about surveys can be found at <https://lmta.lt/lt/kokybe/apklauso/>.

The LMTA has students whose studies are statefunded and those who finance their studies on their own.

Students whose first-cycle studies are statefunded continue receiving the state funding only if they meet the set achievement criteria after the assessment period established by the LMTA. If a student fails to meet the criteria of good academic achievements, they become deprived of state funding.

A student who has lost state funding must pay a fixed tuition fee for their studies, while the vacant state-funded place, in accordance with the procedure established by the LMTA, is taken by a student whose studies are not funded by the state and who has demonstrated the best academic achievements in the same field of studies and in the same course and meets the set learning performance criteria. The state-funded and non-statefunded places are ranked in accordance with the procedure established by the LMTA. 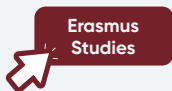

OPPORTUNITIES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDIES

Whatever study cycle you are in (bachelor's, master's, or doctoral studies), the LMTA provides numerous opportunities for studies or a traineeship under the Erasmus+ exchange programme. Studies within Erasmus+ last from three to twelve months, while the duration of a traineeship is two months. To study under Erasmus+, you have to choose a foreign university with which the **LMTA has signed a bilateral agreement**.

It is allowed to study abroad more than once, but priority is given to students who have not yet participated in the Erasmus+ exchange programme. Students who participate in the Erasmus+ are awarded a grant. More information about grants and their rates is here: **LMTA | Erasmus studies**.

LMTA also offers Erasmus Mundus Joint Master programmes – **ReSound** and **DocNomadsPlus**. These programmes are carried out together with leading European universities and give students the opportunity to study in several countries and obtain a joint degree.

WHAT IS EDINA?

Lithuanian information system for the management of science, studies, activities and processes.

Once logged in, you can:

- View the requirements for your study programme (specialisation);
- View your current semester timetable;
- View your course (module) grades after the examination period;
- View completed courses (modules);
- At the end of the semester, evaluate the content and teaching quality of a course (module) and view the summarised survey results;
- Communicate with lecturers and access other information uploaded to EDINA.

Regulations



An **incentive scholarship** (a recurring or one-off payment) is awarded to high-achieving first- and second-cycle students for academic achievement and active involvement in artistic activities (participation in competitions, festivals, creative projects and/or management activities), research and community activities.

TUITION FEE REDUCTION

LMTA students whose studies are not funded by the state can receive reduction on the fee for the semester of study. For a reduction in tuition fees, please contact the Study Department via email studijos@lmta.lt.

STATE FINANCIAL SUPPORT

- **State-supported loans.** LMTA students can receive state-supported loans to cover tuition fees, living expenses and partial studies.
- **Social scholarships.** Social scholarships are available to first-, second- and third-cycle LMTA students who meet certain eligibility criteria.
- **Tuition fee reimbursement.** Tuition fees may be reimbursed to first- and second-cycle students who have completed the relevant study period or part of it (semester) in a state non-funded study place. Tuition fees are reimbursed to students who have no academic debts, have fulfilled all the requirements for the relevant study period and have achieved the best academic results.
- **Support for Lithuanians expats.** The State Studies Foundation provides support to Lithuanian expats who study at LMTA.
- **Support for students with disabilities.** Students with disabilities may receive targeted allowances and payments to cover special needs. Students studying in state non-funded study places may receive partial reimbursement of study-related expenses. LMTA students with disabilities can receive information and support from the LMTA Community Wellbeing Centre at bendruomenesgerove@lmta.lt.
- **Support for students with fewer opportunities.** Students with fewer opportunities may receive financial support from LMTA for study-related or one-off expenses in exceptional circumstances, as well as funding to cover special needs.
